3) Spiritual realities must be Spiritually _____.

[63] It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life. [64] But there are some of you who do not believe."

A.W. Tozer: "The reason why many are still troubled, still seeking, still making little forward progress is because they haven't yet come to the end of themselves. We're still trying to give orders, and interfering with God's work within us."

Go Deeper: Read Galatians 5:13-25. What does it mean to "walk in the Spirit" according to this passage? Have you come to the end of yourself? In what ways are you still "giving orders and interfering with God's work within you?"
