Psalm 24:4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false...

Psalm 86:11 Teach me your way, O LORD, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name.

Psalm 103:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name!

Ephesians 5:18b-19 ... be filled with the Spirit, [19] addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart

Isaiah 29:13 "This people draw near with their mouth and honor me with their lips, while their hearts are far from me, and their fear (NIV: worship) of me is a commandment taught by men."

4) WORSHIP IS TO HONOR WITH EXTRAVAGANT _____ AND _____.

Romans 12:1 I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.
